October 23, 2014 – ***“PETER & PAUL and the CHRISTIAN REVOLUTION,” – Episode I*** - a presentation produced by PBS (2010), depicting how Peter, infused with resurrection hope and great determination, united followers of *“The Way”* into a tightly-knit community; and, the help he received from an unexpected source whose name was Paul. We will engage in directed discussion on the differences between political, social and religious movements, then and now.

November 20, 2014 – ***“Respect – Key to Living - Christ is our Example”*** (1 Peter 2:13–25)

December 4, 2014 – ***“Respect for everyone, especially Wives/Husbands”*** (1 Peter 3:1-12)

December 11, 2014 – ***“Doing Good in Mutual Love– Key to Community”*** (1 Peter 3:13 – 4:11)

December 18, 2014 – ***“Responsibilities of Church & Elders in Times of Trial”*** (1 Peter 4:12-5:11)
